

# ORDINANCE ADDRESSING FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT PROVISIONS

## OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE

Community Name: Lake Township, County: Huron

**Ordinance Number 2008-03.**

An ordinance amendment to affirm an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Lake located in Huron County, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

The Township of Lake Ordains:

**Section 1. AGENCY DESIGNATED.** Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Building Official of the Township of Lake is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Lake under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Township of Lake assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act through out the corporate limits of the community adopting this ordinance.

**Section 2. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED.** Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the Township of Lake.

**Section 3. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS.** The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled Huron County, Michigan, Flood Insurance Study Number 26063CV000A and dated December 2, 2008 and the Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) (FIRMS) panel number(s) of 26063C: 175D, 130D, 135D, 140D, 145D and 155D and dated December 2, 2008 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code.

**Section 4. REPEALS.** All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 5. PUBLICATION.** This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.
