Millage Renewal for Services to Older Citizens

As a renewal of the rate previously approved by the electors which expires with the 2021 tax levy, shall the previously voted increase in the 15.50 mill tax limitation imposed under Article 9, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on all general ad valorem taxes within the County of Huron be renewed at 2.5/10 of one mill (\$.25 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for a period of five years (2022 through 2026 inclusive) to provide funds to maintain and expand services to older citizens in Huron County, and shall the County of Huron levy such renewal in millage for said purpose, thereby, raising in the first year an estimated \$626,172? The funds so collected are to be administered by the Huron County Board of Commissioners.

Millage Renewal for Huron County Department of Veterans' Affairs

As a renewal of the rate previously approved by the electors which expires with the 2021 tax levy, shall the previously voted increase in the 15.50 mill tax limitation imposed under Article 9, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on all general ad valorem taxes within the County of Huron be renewed at .08 of one mill (\$.08 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for a period of five years (2022 through 2026 inclusive) to provide funds to equip, operate, maintain, and provide support and assistance services to veterans through a county Department of Veterans' Affairs, and shall the County of Huron levy such renewal millage for said purpose, thereby, raising in the first year an estimated \$200,375? The funds so collected are to be administered by the Huron County Board of Commissioners.
