he Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a pre-hearing to consider Consumers Energy Company's (Consumers Energy) May 31, 2024 application requesting the Commission to: 1) determine that Consumers Energy's 2023 Energy Waste Reduction (EWR) Plan reconciliation is reasonable and rudent and meets all relevant requirements under Act 295; 2) approve the collection of a financial performance incentive payment for both the natural gas and electric EWR Plan, the collection of which is to be completed by December 11, 2025, in order to comply with the requirements of Accounting Standards Codification 980-605-25; 3) approve the EWR surcharge mechanism as proposed by Consumers Energy; 4) approve the conversion of 168,429 EWR Credits into Renewable Energy Credits in 2023 for use in meeting Consumers Energy's enewable energy requirements under Act 295; and 5) grant Consumers Energy ther and further relief as may be lawful and appropriate.
