## **Zoning News...**

The planning commission has drafted a new exterior lighting ordinance. It is anticipated it will be ready for a public hearing early next year. The changes should remedy the lack of clarity in the current ordinance and prove to be more specific as to the type of lighting to use in residential and commercial settings as well as lumens and proper shading needed in residential districts.

Fall is here! Be kind and clean up your leaves.

Erosion fences are allowed on the beach now until May 1st.

This was a good year for new

construction. Lake Township has had eight new homes built along with several additions, decks, garages and pole sheds.

We are still working on a small shed ordinance that needs to be addressed. I have noticed small sheds made of resin (plastic) popping up in backyards. These sheds still require a land use permit.

#### **Sheriff Patrol**

During the 2013 year, the Township hired the Huron County Sheriff Department for road patrol within Lake Township. They worked primarily during the weekends, holidays, Cheeseburger Caseville and during opening days of Bow Hunting Season and Gun Hunting Season. The Township Board budgeted \$10,000 for this service because of several complaints about ORV's and the reckless discharge of firearms. Township also implemented a Fireworks Ordinance.

The Township Board set up a Public Safety Committee to discuss all these issues. Township Trustee Dale Hartsell is the Chairman of the Committee. If you have any concerns or dates and times that you would like to see Sheriff patrol, feel free to contact the Township Hall or email the Township with your concerns or suggestions.

Please call 989-856-9198 and leave your name, address, phone number and date you will be burning. Leaves and brush are the only things permitted to be burned. **NEVER** leave your fire unattended. **It is unlawful to burn garbage.** 

### **Security**

We suggest that all seasonal residents refrain from leaving valuable articles such as jewelry, firearms, or expensive electronics in their home. It might be a good idea to arrange for snow removal to make thieves think you are in residence.

#### From the Clerk's desk...

As Lake Township Clerk, I am responsible for elections held in our district. So far we have elections scheduled for August 5, 2014 for the Primary and November 4, 2014 for the General Election. I would like to remind you, if you have recently moved to our Township and will be voting here, remember to change your driver's license address at a Secretary of State office. They will notify us of the change of address and your corrected voter registration.

Things you might not know when voting:

All Michigan voters must show photo ID when voting at the polls.

First-time voters who register by mail must vote in person the first time they vote.

When applying for an absentee

ballot at the Clerk's office, you must show your I.D. to the clerk before a ballot will be issued.

You can vote by Absentee Ballot by filling out an Absentee Voter Application before the election. The qualifications for requesting an Absentee Ballot are as follows:

- 1. I expect to be absent from the community in which I am registered for the entire time the polls are open on election day.
- 2. I am physically unable to attend the polls without the assistance of another.
- 3. I cannot attend the polls because of the tenets of my religion.
- 4. I have been appointed an election precinct inspector in a precinct other than the precinct where I reside.
- 5. I am 60 years of age, or older.
- 6. I cannot attend the polls because I am confined to jail

awaiting arraignment or trial.

If you need to be put on a Permanent Absentee list for any of these reasons listed, we have a form at the Township Hall and on the Township's website which needs to be completed and sent to me. Be aware that IF you are on a Permanent Absentee Voter list, I will automatically send you an Absentee Voter Application before every election, to verify that you want a ballot for that specific election. When I receive your completed application back, I will send the actual ballot as available to me

It has been a pleasure serving our Township these past five months, and I hope to continue as your Clerk in 2014. If you have any questions that I can help with, please feel free to call our office at 989-856-4867.

## **Household Garbage Pick-up Survey**



Diva Disposal has contacted the Lake Township Board of Trustees regarding a proposal they would like to offer for curbside trash pickup with recycling. Residents would be charged for this service on their tax bill (vacant lots would not be included). Neighboring communities pay \$134 to \$152 annually per household.

Lake Township currently offers trash drop off for a fee at the Township Transfer Station on Sand Road with free monthly recycling drop off and free drop off of grass clippings, leaves, and small brush. The Board of Trustees would like to hear from residents as to whether they prefer maintaining the current drop off facility or would rather have curbside pickup at a rate to be determined by accepting bids from local sanitation services. This will only be pursued at this time if there is enough interest in this pickup service.
