Gypsy Moth ALERT

We are asking residents to contact the Township to let us know if they have evidence of gypsy moth egg masses on their property or in their area. We have posted information as to what these masses look like on our website. Please contact us if you have any so we can make an informed decision on spraying in 2020.

If you had gypsy moth caterpillar infestations this past summer, please let us know that also.

Lakeshore Property ALERT

We have had high winds causing extensive beach erosion in some areas this fall, loss of decks and damage to some seawalls. If you have a seasonal lakefront cottage, we recommend that you evaluate your property periodically during the winter/spring season to avoid and/or mitigate potential damage.

IF PAYING WITH CASH IN THE OFFICE PLEASE HAVE THE EXACT AMOUNT. Additional hours for in person tax payments at the Lake Township Hall are **Monday, December 30, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Monday, March 2, 2020 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

You may drop off your payment by check, only on any other day and a receipt will be mailed to you, **if requested.** There is also a secure drop box located in the entrance for tax payments by check, only.
